*New Every Morning
Lamentations 3:22-23*

(Note: This month's devotion is adapted from a post on my BeanSpired Editions Facebook page [August 22, 2022]. Being halfway through 2026 and in the midst of so much change, I thought we could all use a reminder of God's ever-fresh faithfulness and love.)

Lamentations 3:22-23 is a passage many of us are familiar with. These verses have been widely quoted, even made into songs like Thomas O. Chisholm's "Great Is Thy Faithfulness." They're a beautiful reminder of God's unending love. As is the case with even the most well-worn scriptures, we could study this passage phrase by phrase and unpack limitless treasure. But for this devotion, I want to hone in on the first half of verse 23: "[His mercies] are new every morning." New. Every. Morning. Think about it. Not only is God's compassion unending, it's fresh every day. We don't wake up to yesterday's leftovers. God doesn't keep an ongoing tally of how much mercy He serves us each day. The jar is as full this morning as it was the day we were created, and will be just as full tomorrow.

So if you find yourself anxiously checking your mercy-supply—maybe even trying to ration it by only asking God for so much—take a deep breath and embrace the promise in these verses. Your loving God will never stop loving you. He'll give you exactly what your soul needs each day. Praise Him for His great love and faithfulness. Thank Him for each new mercy. And start each day with open-handed confidence that He goes with you and meets you with compassion that never grows old.

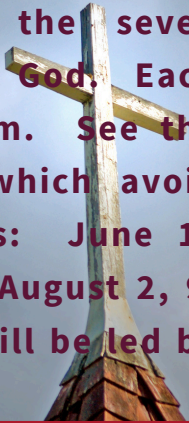
Senior Prayer Warrior Ministry:

Outreach Update!

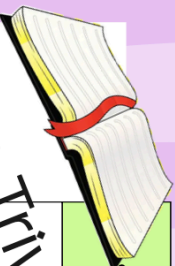

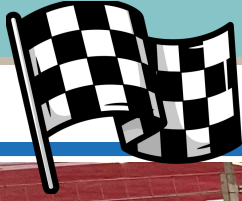
